The MFWD Organization

The Manolo Fortich Water District created by virtue of Presidential Decree 198 otherwise known as the “Provincial Water Utilities Act” as amended through Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 48 dated July 7, 1988 is a government owned and controlled corporation.

As a government entity, it has a mandate of providing public service to the community through delivery of safe and potable water from the source to individual household service connection. MFWD holds a Certificate of Conformance no. 401 issued by Local Water Utilities administration on June 8, 1989. It is an income

generating and self-sustaining agency whose revenue is derived from water sales and other water services income and does not received any financial appropriation from the national coffers.

MFWD provides services to 11 of the 22 barangays of Manolo Fortich and 2 barangays of the adjacent Cagayan de Oro City. MFWD is a Category "C" as categorized on March 14, 2012 by the Local Water Utilities Administration in compliance with DBM Circular no. 2011-10 dated November 18, 2011. Currently MFWD has a total active service connection of 9,167 serving a total population of 55,002 as of August 31, 2017.
